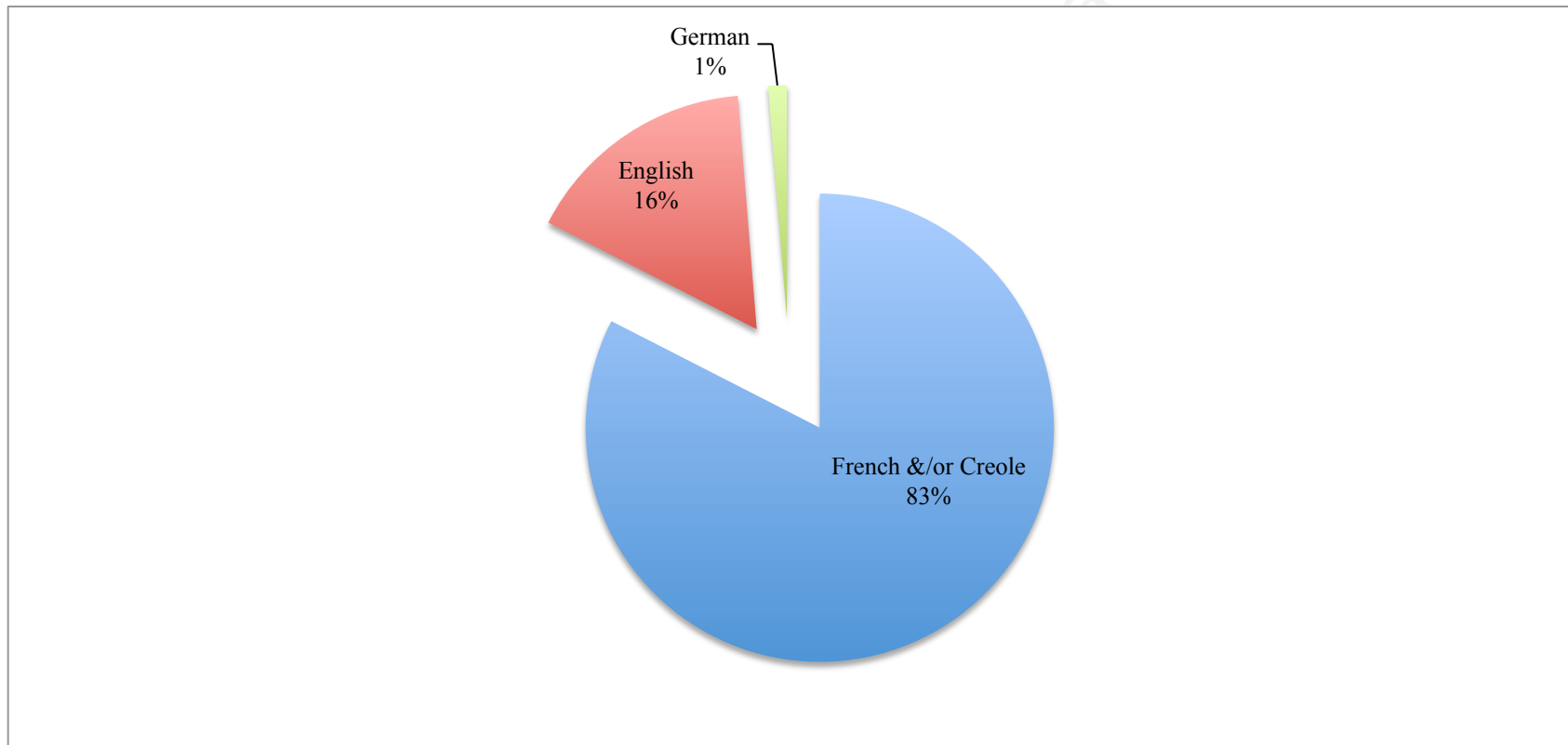

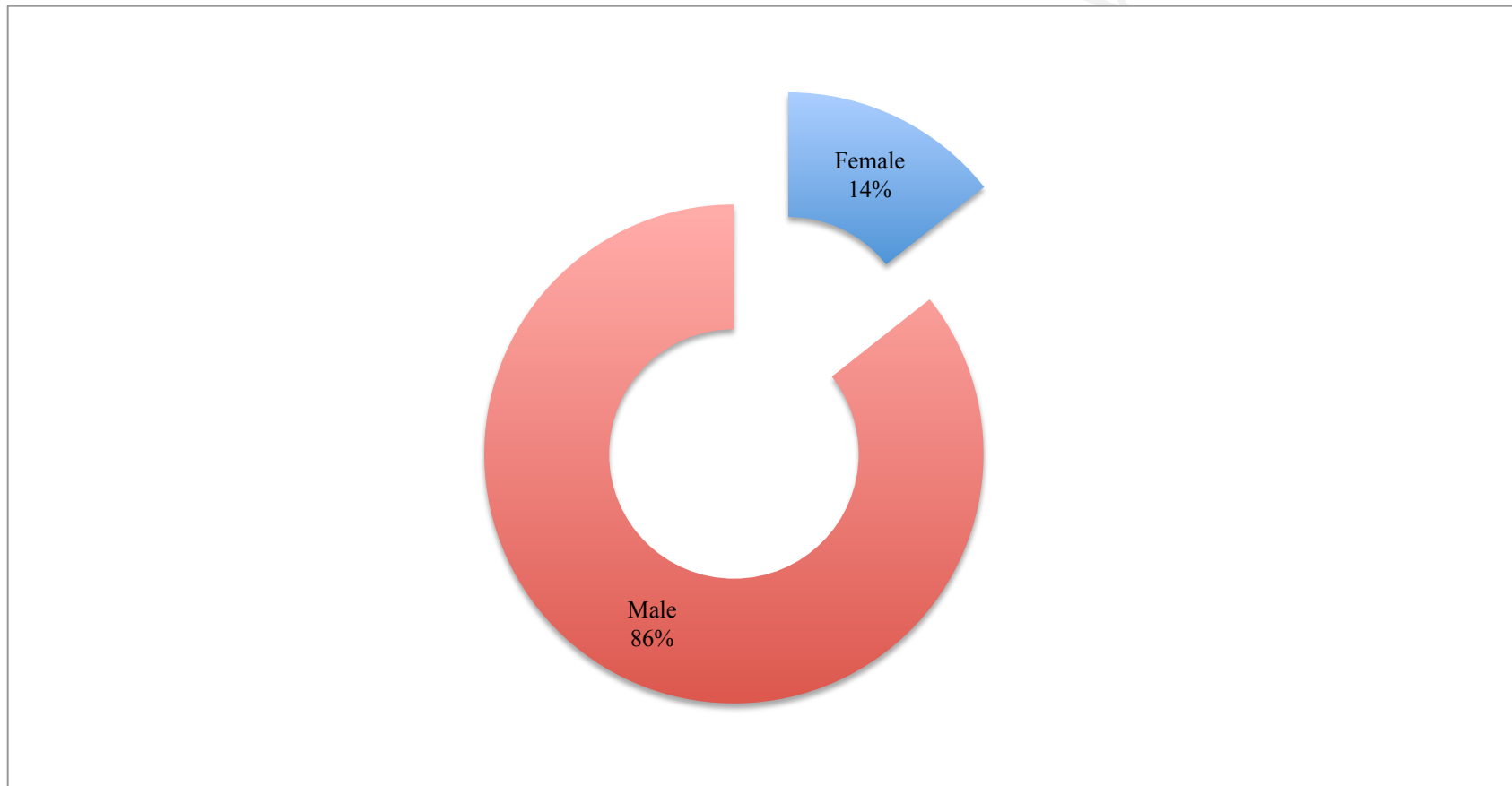

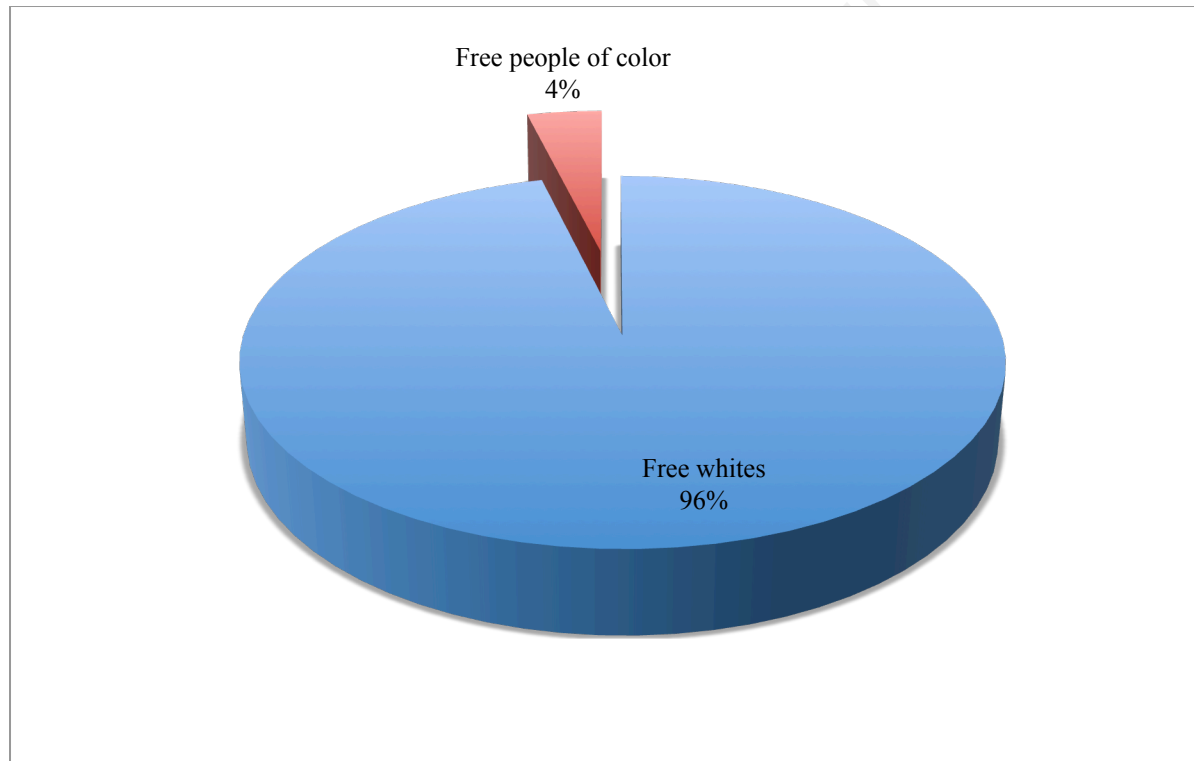
Slaveholders by Gender

ⁱTwo slaveholding heads of households were born in the Caribbean: St-Rose R. DE ST-LAURENT and his wife Rose Suzanne MONGÉ were both born in Guadeloupe as was Dr. David DE LAURÉAL. Guadeloupean Creole is—and has been—the lingua franca of Guadeloupeans, even though a minority may have spoken French in the 19th century as well. Rose MONGÉ DE ST-LAURENT operated a boarding school at St. Martinville known as the *Pensionnat St-Laurent*.
