SIMILAR RESEARCH BY CHRISTOPHE LANDRY

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Assistant Census Marshal, Louis Andrus,¹ did a wonderful service for researchers. He not only provided us with the names of the various communities throughout St. Landry Parish in 1830, but in his enumeration tables, he also demonstrated the linguistic character of the civil parish through phonetic spellings of names and usage of French and English social titles and civil statuses.

The pages to follow only include St. Landry Parish's slave holders in 1830. They contain the slave holder's surname, forename, civil status, descent, locality, page number on the original enumeration tables, and the number of slaves owned. Since this research sought to study slave ownership among Louisiana Creoles of Acadian descent in St. Landry Parish, in the column for descent, I only indicate if the slave holder is of Acadian descent. All other descents have been excluded.

To help guide other researchers, I have converted the phonetic spellings of forenames and surnames of the Creole inhabitants into the most common spellings in 2016. However, it was important to use proper diacritics on both inhabitants' names and on localities since French and Creole—rather than English—represented the *linguae francae* of the region in 1830. For diacritics on the names of localities, I chose to use the spellings used in state acts passed during the 13th, 14th, and 15th Louisiana legislatures over the course of the 1820s, 30s and 40s. Acts passed during these legislatures were published in French and in English.²

The “status” column contains some abbreviations likely unfamiliar to the reader/researcher. They include: Miss (unmarried), Mrs. (married or older woman), FPOC (free people of color in the household), Nun (Catholic Nun), Priest (Roman Catholic Priest), *V^{ve}* (veuve – widow), and Wid. (widow). All of these appear in the table to follow exactly as written by the assistant census marshal. Some are therefore in French while others are in English.

Andrus identified the following localities in the civil parish: (1) Opélousas, (2) Bayou Carron, (3) Prairie Barrée, (4) Bellevue, (5) Plaquemines-Brûlées, (6) Queue-de-Tortue, (7) River Mermentau, (8) Carencro, (9) Grand-Côteau, (10) Bayou Darbonne, (11) Grande-Prairie, (12) Prairie Mamou, (13) Prairie Ronde, (14) Prairie Plaisance, (15) Chataignier, (16) Garland, (17) L'Anse-aux-Pailles, (18) Bayou Chicot, (19) Bayou Bœuf, (20) Prairie Côteau, (21) Faiquétaïque, (22) Bayou Mallet, (23) Bayou-des-Cannes, (24) Prairie-des-Femmes, (25) Bayou Gathe, (26) Ville-Platte, (27) Prairie Chantot, (28) Reder Ridge, (29) Gatt Most, (30) Prairie Laurent, (31) Mount Botte, (32) Côteau, (33) Calcasieu, (34) Plaquemines, (35) River Calcasieu, (36) Bayou Têche, and a few other illegible localities. Note that some of these have new names (e.g. Plaquemines-Brûlées is now Church Point), and others have been anglicized (e.g. Bellevue is Bellevue). These localities show clues of ethnic clustering. For instance, Anglophone inhabitants were sprinkled throughout the civil parish, but were especially numerous on the rivers Mermentau and Calcasieu, and also at Plaquemines-Brûlées, Opélousas, Bayou Darbonne, and Queue-de-Tortue.

It is useful to point out that in 1830, St. Landry Parish still covered much of what was the Poste-des-Opélousas during the colonial period. In other words, the 1830 parish included present-day St. Landry Parish, in addition to present-day Acadia, Evangeline, and Jefferson Davis parishes, and parts of Lafayette, St. Martin, Cameron and Calcasieu parishes.
