* Joseph Bélanoir GAUTREAUX was born 4 Feb 1830 in Plattenville, Assumption Parish, to Charles Rosémond GAUTREAUX of Plattenville, and to Françoise PERCLE of St. Jean-the-Baptist Parish. He married 23 September 1867 Charlotte LE NORMAND – free woman of color, native of St. Martin Parish, daughter of *de feu* Charles Ursin LE NORMAND – free man of color native of New Orleans, and of Marie-Louise-Adéline LE SASSIER – free woman of color, native of St. Charles Parish, both previously residents of Fausse Pointe or Pointe Claire in St. Martin Parish (SM Ch v 10 #150). Joseph died 24 September 1897 in New Orleans. Charlotte died 9 April 1900 in New Orleans.
