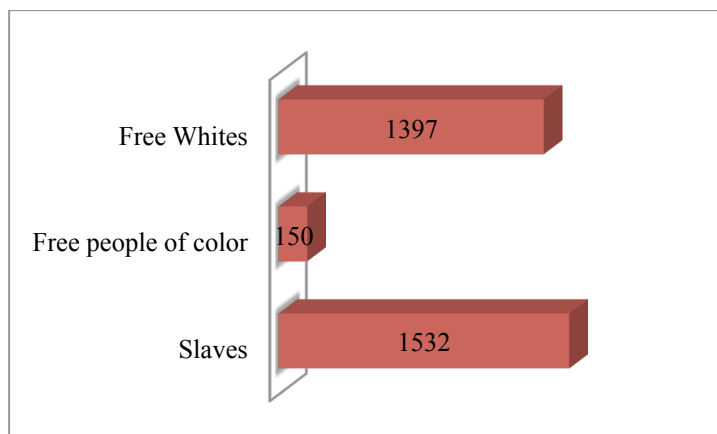

## Linguistic Summary of All Heads of Household Enumerated

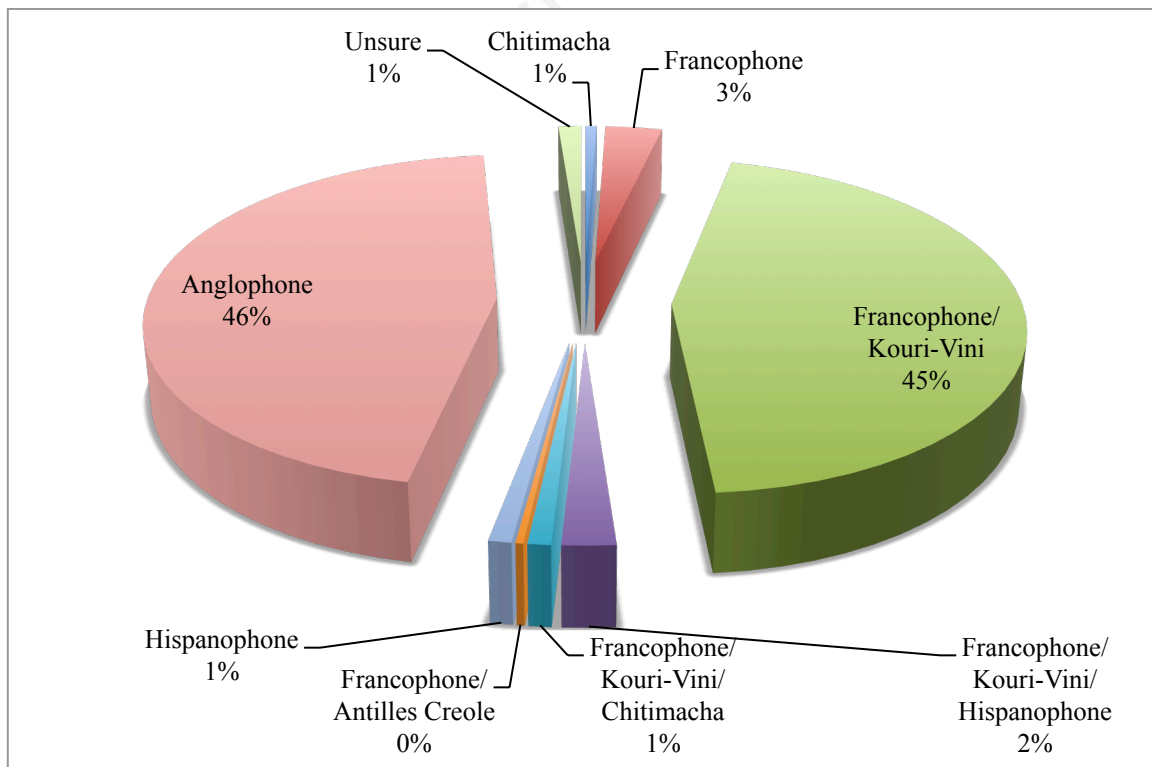
This summary is based on the birthplace and closest relations of the head of each household. French and Kouri-Vini are both wide-spread languages in Têche Country – the old Attakapas Military District and Trading Post, whose seat was at St. Martinville – by "white" and "nonwhite" persons. This is especially true in St. Martin, Iberia and the Creole enclaves in St. Mary Parish. It is difficult to ascertain who speaks which in the records, so I have arranged them in one group.

The MASSEs (André, Angélique, Paul, Grégoire) were the first non-Indigenous people to permanently settle in Têche Country. We know from extant civil and parochial records that they were on Bayou Têche as early as 1748, and formed enduring relationships with the Chitimacha. They had to know French (most were born in colonial Louisiana), and likely are among the first speakers of Kouri-Vini.

A few Spaniards born in the provinces of Extramadura, Granada, Málaga, Mallorca and Minorca, as well as the Canary Islands, were still alive in this census. Records suggest that many continued to speak Spanish, as they are identified by their original names, in Spanish. Their children and grandchildren, already spoke French and/or Kouri-Vini, as reflected in naming patterns among them (both forenames and surnames).

Anglophones in this census overwhelmingly came from Anglophone U.S. states. A few were born in the British Isles.
